

# **BEVERLEY TOWN COUNCIL**

## **2<sup>nd</sup> January 2018 Youth Coalition Meeting Notes**

**1. Introductions around the table** - Cllr Begnett welcomed members to the meeting and chaired the meeting.

**2. To receive the notes from the meeting on 6<sup>th</sup> June 2017** – The notes were received.

**3. To receive an update on the PAG to be spent by 31<sup>st</sup> March 2018, and other possible funding** – Cllr Begnett reported on the PAG funding spend criteria and the concept to operate a one-off youth workshop in Woodmansey, Molescroft and in Beverley. Discussion took place on the matter and members agreed it was a good idea to work on the Molescroft and Woodmansey event in the half term school holidays from 19-23 February 2018, to then follow with the Beverley event in the Easter School holidays. Members agreed to form a working group of Cllrs Heffer, Cllr Oliver, Cllr Begnett along with some support from Darron Lawer. A meeting was arranged for **Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> January 2018 at 5pm at Beverley Town Council Office.**

**4. To discuss facilities and funding required along with possible activities to be offered by the Youth Umbrella/Coalition Group as analysed in the recent Youth Coalition survey** – Cllrs Heffer and Oliver discussed possible meeting places in their parishes, such as Tsar Skatepark, Molescroft Pavillion and Let Loose, both Cllrs will report back to the next meeting regarding interest, costs and availability. Member discussed a possible venue for the Beverley events.

**5. To discuss Volunteer, Community Group involvement and resource/staffing infrastructure required to deliver the project** – Members briefly discussed resources, activities, staffing and volunteers needed to complete the tasks. Activity ideas, such as Graffiti workshops, climbing walls, parklife, rodeo bulls, DJ workshop, Beverley Rocks, sport and art sessions. Cllr Begnett to contact the local sporting clubs for support. Barron Lawer can provide some names and contacts details for DJ and Graffiti workshops. Discussion also took place on promotion and using the concept of a town completion for young people to design a Youth Caption logo at the workshops.

**6. To discuss operational matters regarding safeguarding, risk assessment and insurance required** – Darron Lawer volunteered to support with templates for youth activity risk assessments.
