26 To receive and accept apologies for absence

Apologies were received from Councillors Dodsworth, McGrath and Pearson.

27 (a) To record declarations of interest by any member of the council in respect of the agenda items listed below. Members declaring interests should identify the agenda item and type of interest being declared.

28 To elect a Chair for the municipal year

Councillor Aird proposed and Councillor Elvidge seconded Councillor Jack be elected as Chair for the municipal year. All agreed.

Resolved: Councillor Jack be elected as Chair for the municipal year.

29 To elect a Vice-Chair for the municipal year

Councillor Aird proposed and Councillor Cooper seconded Councillor Elvidge be elected as Vice Chair for the municipal year. All agreed.

Resolved: Councillor Elvidge be elected as Vice Chair for the municipal year.

Councillor Jack welcomed everyone to the meeting and explained the process.

Councillor Jack said the application forms were very informative and each representative would be invited to give a short presentation on their application. At the end of the presentations, applicants are able to leave the meeting whilst Councillors discuss the applications.

30 To consider the following Grant Applications:

(i) Beverley Civic Society - £300

12 Extraordinary Beverley Women 2018

Image Projection of 12 Extraordinary Beverley Women 2018 – St Mary's Church to Beverley Arms

Power: Local Government Act 1972. S144 – Tourism

Discussion took place and members recommended that £300 be awarded to the project.

Recommended – That the sum of £300 be awarded to the project.

(ii) Other Live Productions - £1500

Fallen Leaves Show to take place 100 years later in commemoration of close of WW1

Power: Local Government Act 1972 Section 145

Contributions to Director and Actor fees (£1000), Publicity (£50) Sets, Props and Costumes (£150), Percentage of ticket sales to venues (£200) Transport (£30) and Light/Sound/Technical equipment (£70)

Discussion took place and members recommended that £1300 be awarded to the project. Members did not wish to pay the percentage of ticket sales to venues.

Recommended – That the sum of £1300 be awarded to the project.

(iii) Beverley Minster Choir - £2350

Choir Tour to Stendal in October 2018 for two concerts, Sunday morning service and potential workshop to enhance twinning links

Power: Local Government Act 1972 Section 145

Contribution towards the cost of travel by coach (£700), ferry (£1000) accommodation (£400) catering (£200) and participation in cultural activities (£50)

Discussion took place and members recommended that £2350 be awarded to the project. Members noted the Choir were very active with their fund raising.

Recommended – That the sum of £2350 be awarded to the project.

(iv) Stage4Beverley Limited - £1250

To present a winter festival in Beverley

Power: Local Government Act 1972 Section 145

Artists' fees for concerts, workshops and informal events

Discussion took place and members recommended that £950 be awarded to the project. Members said the grants should not fund salaries and awarded £950 to the project for venue costs/technical equipment.

Recommended – That the sum of £950 be awarded to the project.
